Using creative cooperative learning tasks during a Sensitization training on racism, discrimination, migration etc.

- Title:** Using creative cooperative learning tasks during a Sensitization training on racism, discrimination, migration etc.
- Participants:** Former participants on the ICI course Sensitisation training with reference to migration, racism, discrimination, culture and diversity with strategies for teaching these issues to diverse age groups
- Place:** The course takes place off-line. All course materials will be accessible in a Dropbox folder for downloading and meetings with trainers and other course members will be set occasionally if requested on Microsoft Teams.
- Time:** Participants can register whenever they want and will be sent an invitation to join the platform after sending a bank receipt for payment. From then on they have access to the course materials and trainers for feedback and clarifications for 3 months. We recommend to finish one task per week and send it in for feedback but it is participants own responsibility to manage the time and they will not be prompted by trainer. The course is in that way very flexible and demands self-organization from the participants.
- Objectives:** That the former participants get a review of some ideas concerning the topics of the course especially focusing on workplace training and creating their own cooperative learning tasks.
- Methods:** A range of inputs and tasks will guide participants through the program. Regularly participants will send the trainer their outcomes and get detailed feedback and suggestions for improvements back. They will do this when it suits them within the time frame.
- Outcome:** Participants will have created/drafted two – three cooperative learning tasks, useful for workplace or class training and received feedback from the trainer.
- Preparation:** All participants must ensure that they have Microsoft Teams on their computers for chats and connections with other participants (if they wish).
They must send payment via bank transfer to the ICI account and a receipt of payment to Guðrún (gudrun@ici.is) They will then receive a receipt from ICI.
- Certification:** Participants will get an ICI certificate detailing the course content and completion of same after handing in all required tasks.
- Price:** **190 Euro.** Included in the price is course fee and materials. Materials included are a pdf version of two fully developed and tried out cooperative learning tasks about prejudice, migration, racism etc. and myths on migration and a pdf version of one chapter from the book “Diverse Society/Diverse Classroom”.

Program for Online Course II - FLEX

- Step 1** Participants register to the course, transfer the course fee, send a confirmation of payment. After payment, participants get access to a platform where they find all course materials.
- Step 2** Pre-reading the suggested documents.
- Step 3** Following the program by opening the folders in the right order and following the tasks descriptions.

During the process participants can always book an on-line meeting with the trainer for feedback or clarifications or put up a question on the shared platform with other participants. If participants on the course choose to discuss or share their tasks with other course members, they organize this themselves through the Teams platform.

The Tasks - the ones you need to send in to finish the course are in red

- Task 1 - This task is all about reading and preparing, no need to send anything in.**
- Task 2 – Thoughts and answers should be posted on Teams (just a short text)**
- Task 3 – Share your thoughts and questions to the presentation on Teams if you want to and if you have some questions.**
- Task 4 – Send to Guðrún both task ideas, using the two structures presented in document 4.**
- Task 5 – Send to Guðrún your answers to Task 5a and 5b.**
- Task 6 – Send Guðrún your changes on the cards. If there is another participant from your country, you are welcome to divide the cards and send it in together.**
